

## NASHVILLE PACKING LIST

Pillow, bedding/ sheets and blanket, or sleeping bag
Personal toiletries (towels, soap, shampoo)
Bible, pen, + journal
Clothing - several outfits that can get dirty and/or painted on and are comfortable to work in
Long pants are required at many sites (leggings are not pants). Please pack at least two pairs of long pants
Shorts are okay at some sites, but they must be fingertip length.
No tank tops or sleeveless tops. Shirts must be long enough to raise arms without exposing midriff or
underwear.
We also recommend one long sleeved shirt for sites where you are doing yard work (to
protect against poison ivy + mosquitoes).
Closed-toe shoes. Sandals or flip-flops may be worn around the CSM housing site and shower but be
prepared to change.
Reusable water bottle
Face mask(s)
Fans (optional)
Money for CSM t-shirts (\$15 each), ice cream, or souvenirs

## **DO NOT BRING**

- Anything that is not replaceable or has significant value (jewelry, etc)
- A lot of money we recommend about \$30 as spending money for students
- Drugs, alcohol, knives, guns, weapons of any kind, etc.

## **CELL PHONE POLICY**

Students are not permitted to use their cell phones at ministry sites and phones should be left at the housing site each day. At the housing site, cell phone usage is up to the group leader. Leaders should keep their phones with them.
